

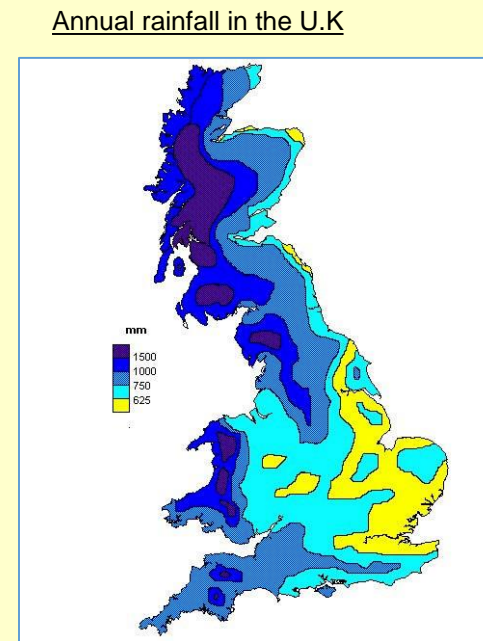
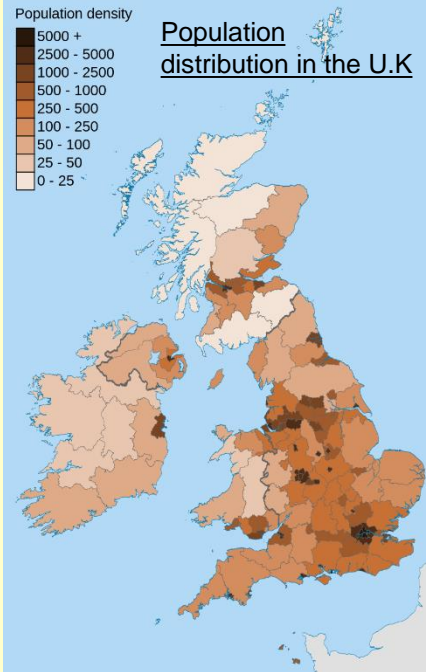
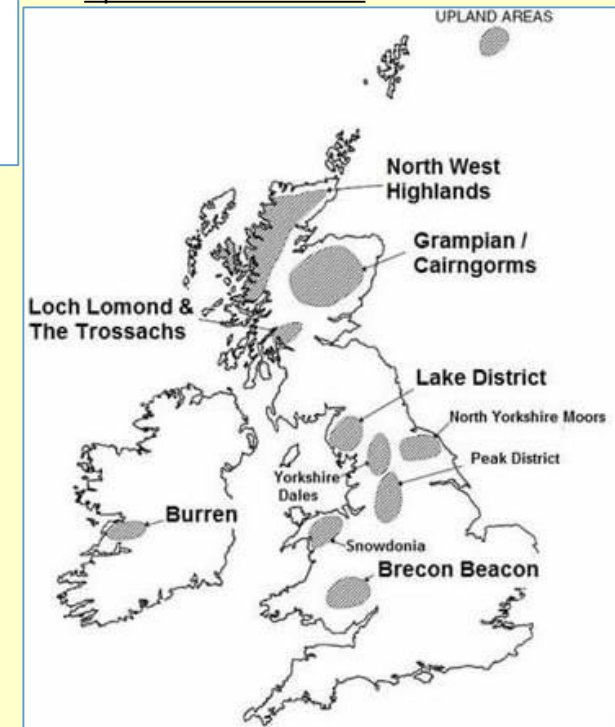


# YEAR 7 KNOWLEDGE ORGANISER: Moving Stories – Why is the population of the U.K changing?

**Densely populated** – places that are crowded  
**Sparsely populated** – places that have very few people  
**Population distribution** – how people are spread out  
**Population density** – a measure of how crowded places are

**Positive factors** – flat land, resources, enough rain, good soil  
**Negative factors** – hills, poor soil, snow, low temperatures

Upland areas in the U.K



Places in the S.E are on flat land, have lower annual rainfall and are densely populated.  
 Places in the N.W are upland areas, have high annual rainfall and are more sparsely populated.

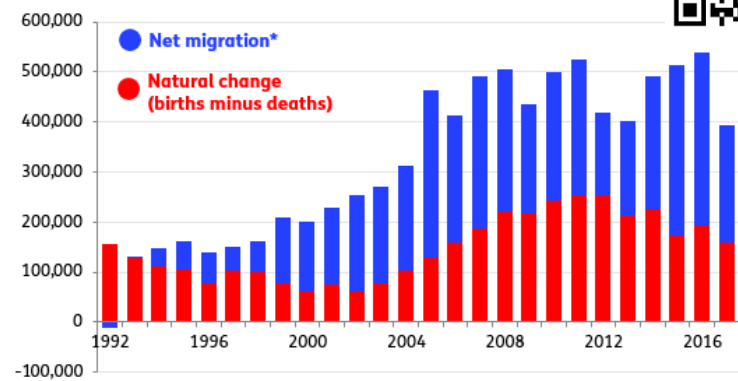
**Push factors** – Bad things that make you want to leave the place where you live.  
**Pull factors** – Good things that attract you to a place.

**Birth rate** - The number of babies born per 1,000 per year  
**Migration** – This is when people move to live in a different place  
**Death rate** – The number of people who die per 1,000 per year  
**Natural increase** – When the birth rate is higher than the death rate

Key Term	Definition
economic migrant	A person who moves to live in another place so that they can get a job and earn money.
refugee	A person who is forced to move house to escape danger.
asylum seeker	A person who moves to live in another country to escape danger and asks to stay there.
emigrant	A person who leaves this country to go and live in another one.
immigrant	A person who comes to live in this country.

Annual population change, UK, from the year to mid-1992, to the year to mid-2017



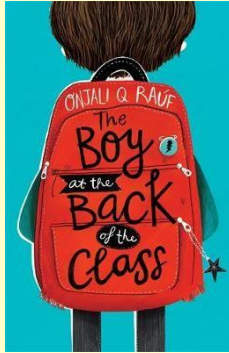

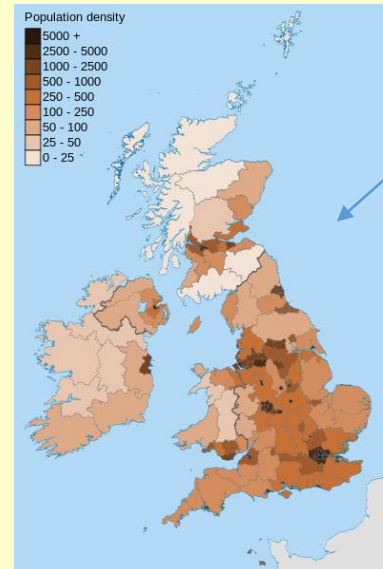
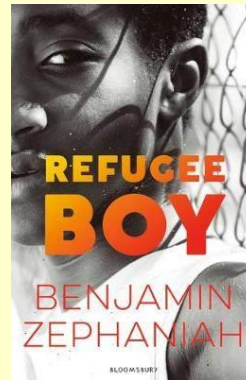
