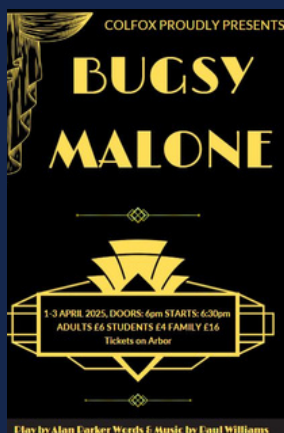

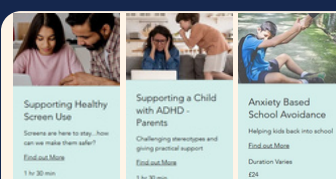


Rehearsals are going well and tickets are already selling fast - get yours now via Arbor.
