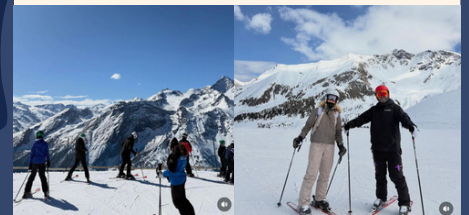


Brilliant Spring Concert!

Are you supporting a child or young person who is autistic or may be autistic? Join our friendly webinar to better understand their needs and explore practical ways to support them at home.

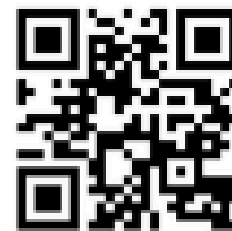
In this 1 hour live session we will:
