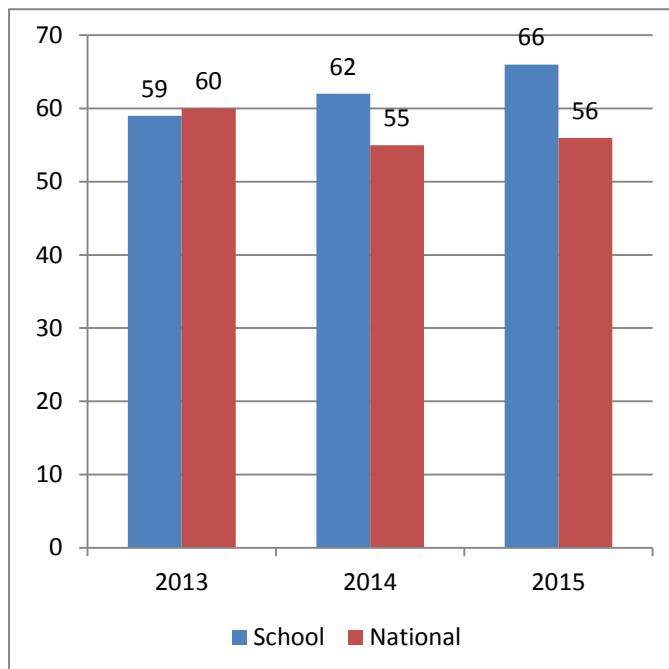


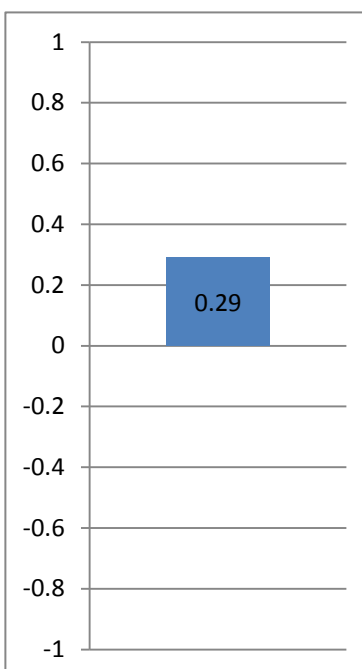
### How well did students perform at the end of year 11?

In 2015 65.96% of students achieved 5 A\*-C including English and Math. This is a 4% increase on 2014.



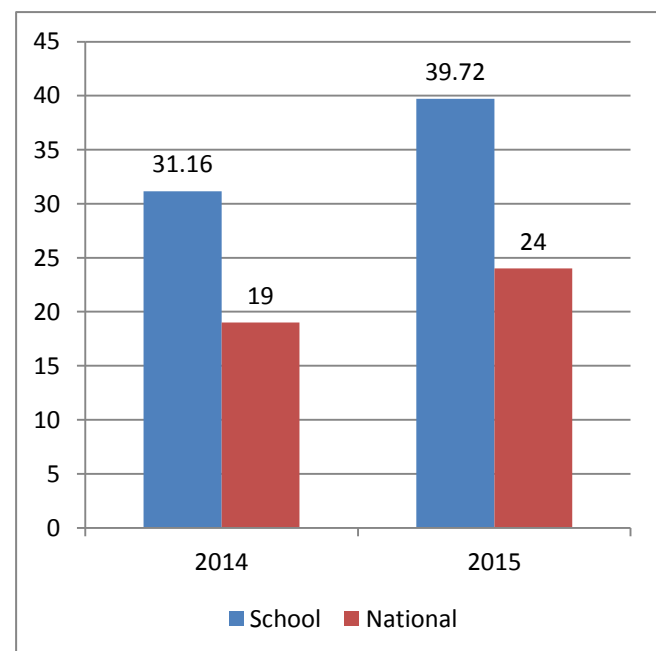
#### Progress8



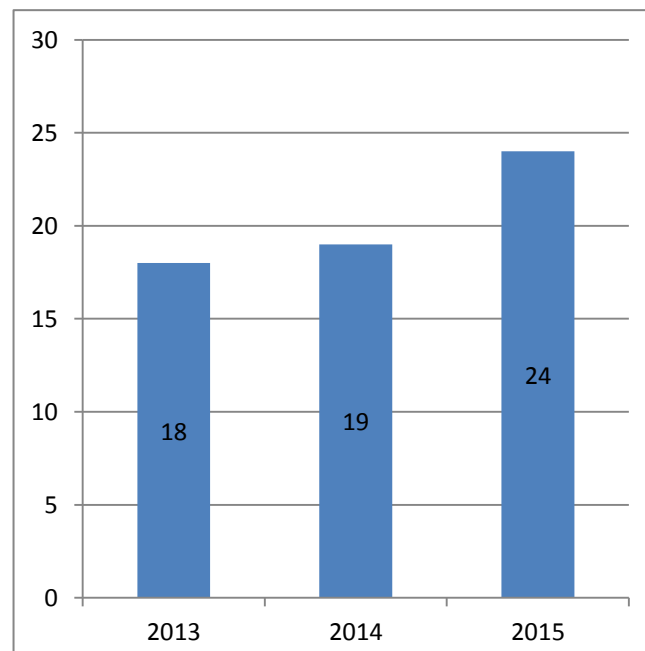
This measure will be used from 2016 in place of the current value added measure. Our score above 0 indicate that students at SJC are making better progress than similar students nationally.

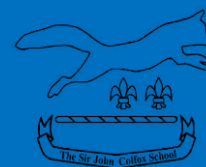
#### English Baccalaureate

#### Percentage of grades at A\*/A



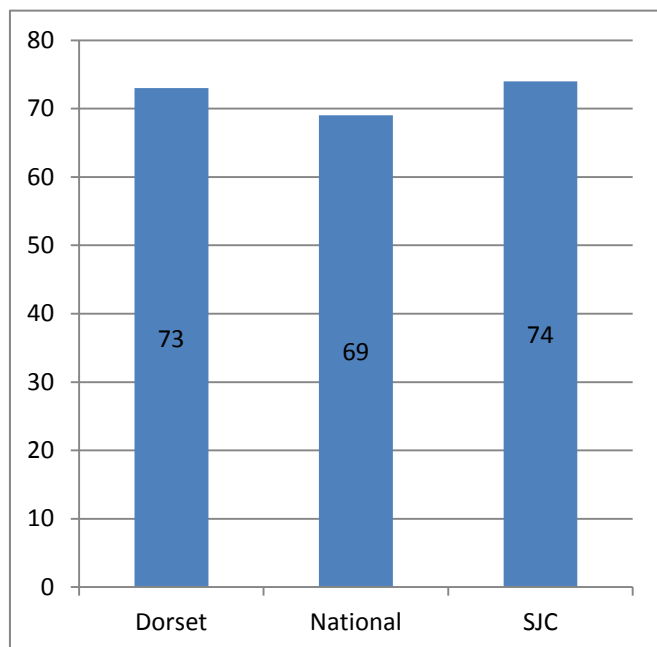

### Are pupils making progress?

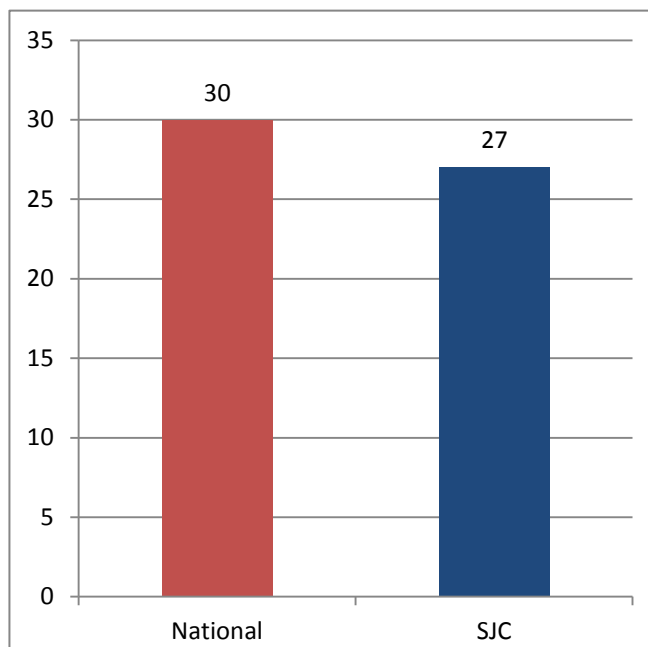
#### Expected progress in English

74% of students made expected (ie 3 levels) progress in English. This is a decrease of 5% since 2014.



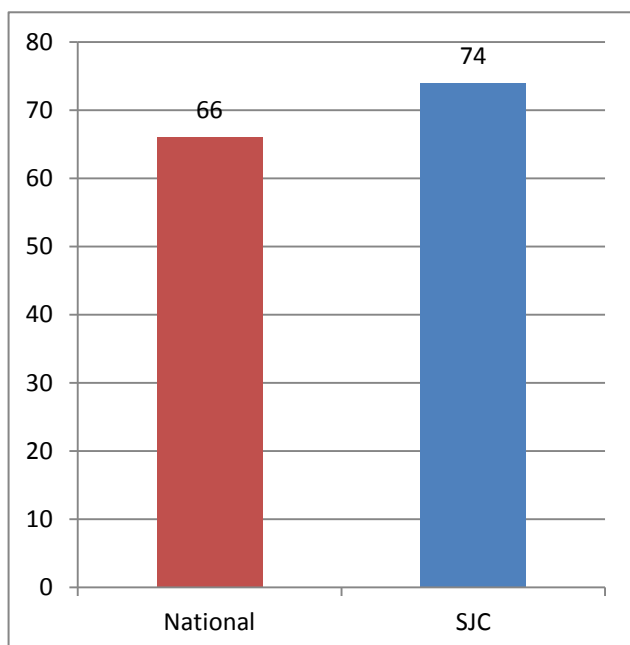
#### Better than expected progress in English

27% of students made better than expected progress. This is a decrease of 2% since 2014 and below the national average of 30%.



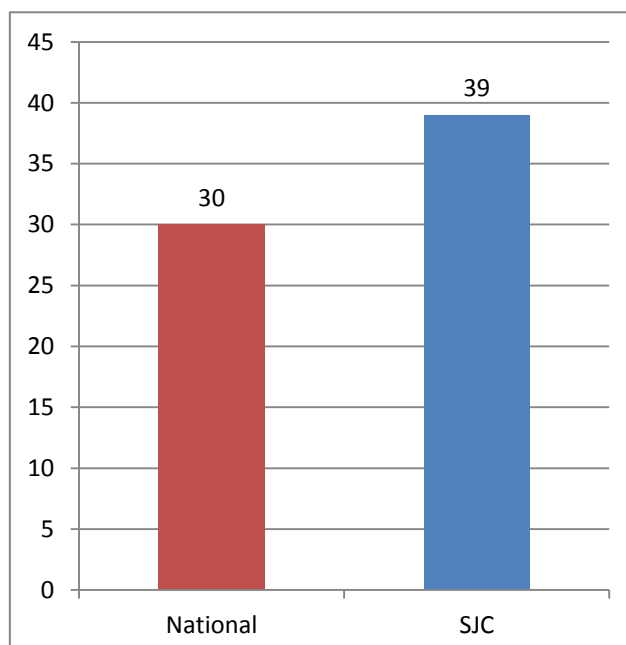
#### Expected progress in Mathematics

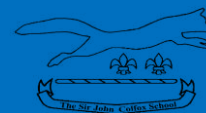
74% of students made expected progress in maths. This is an increase of 12% since 2014 and 8% above the national average.



#### Better than expected progress in Mathematics

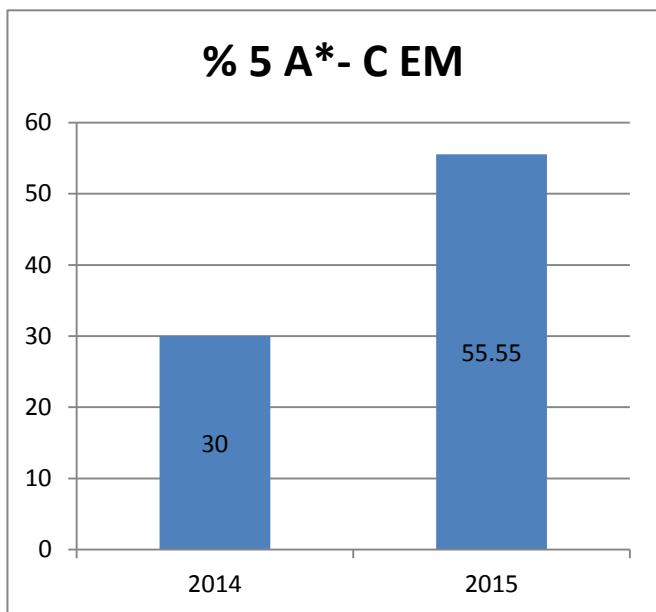
39% of students made better than expected progress in maths. This is an increase of 10% and 9% above the national average.



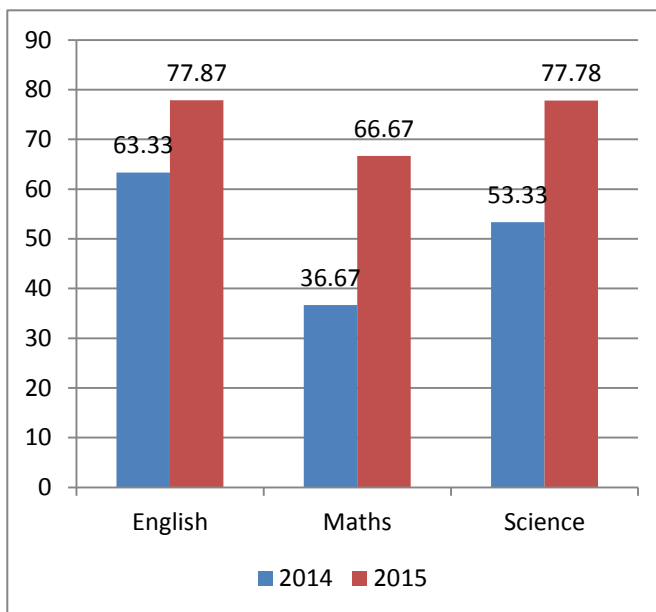


How well did SEN students perform at the end of year 11?

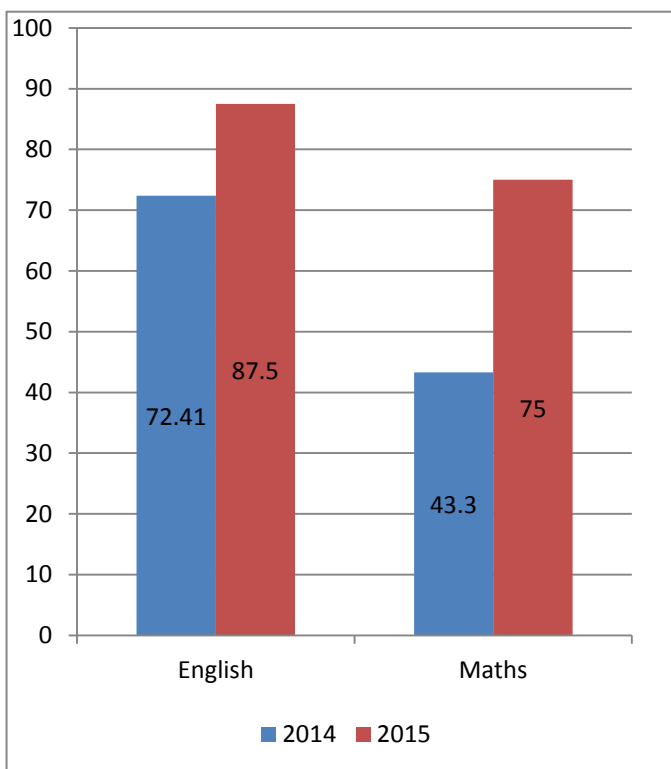
Percentage of SEN students achieving 5 A\*-C including English and Maths.



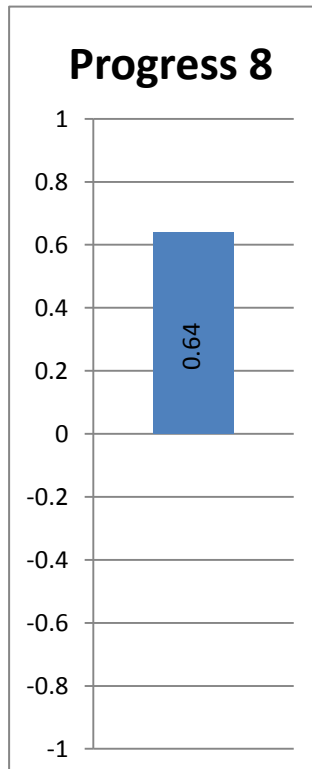
Percentage of SEN students achieving A\*-C in English, Maths and Science.



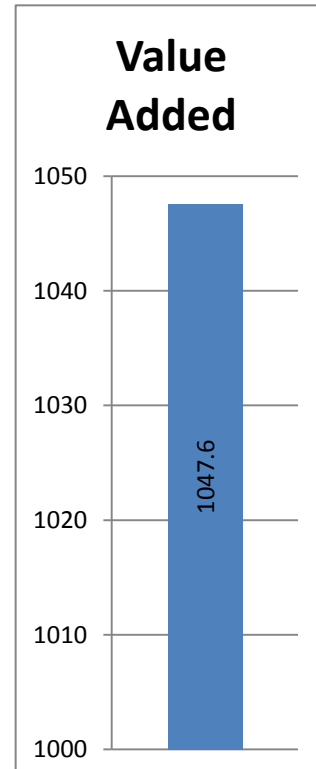
Percentage of SEN students making expected progress in English or Maths

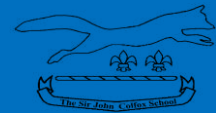

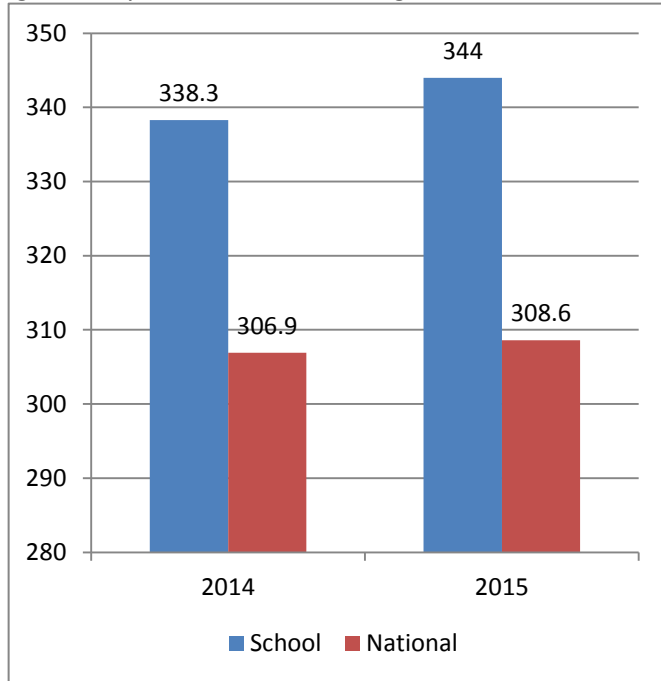


How well did students perform at the end of year 11?

### Average capped point score

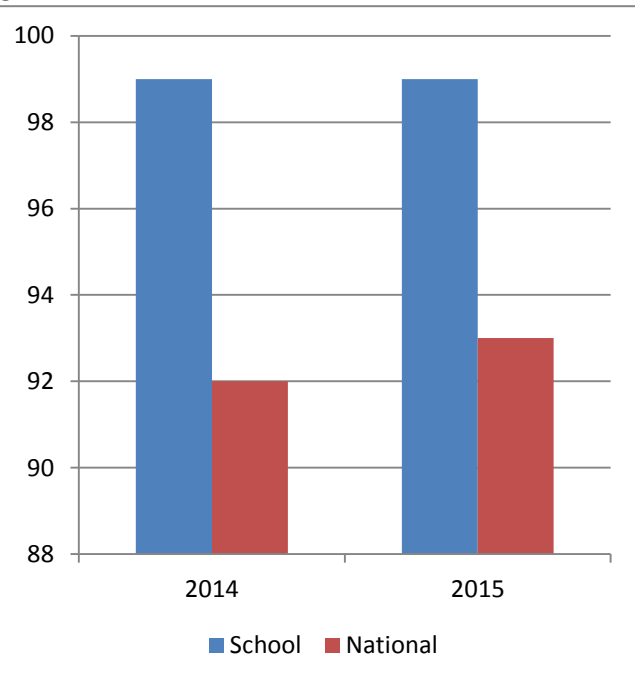
#### - best 8 subjects

At 99%, the school is significantly above the national figure.

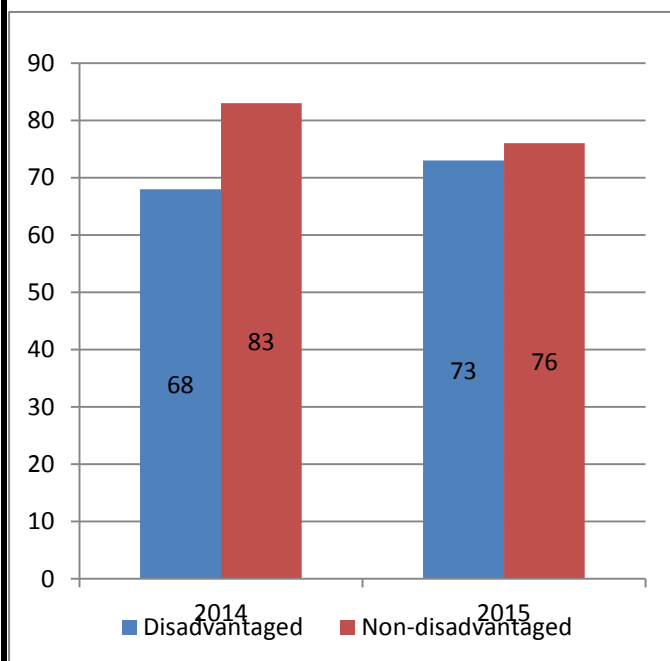




### Is the gap narrowing between disadvantaged students and other students?

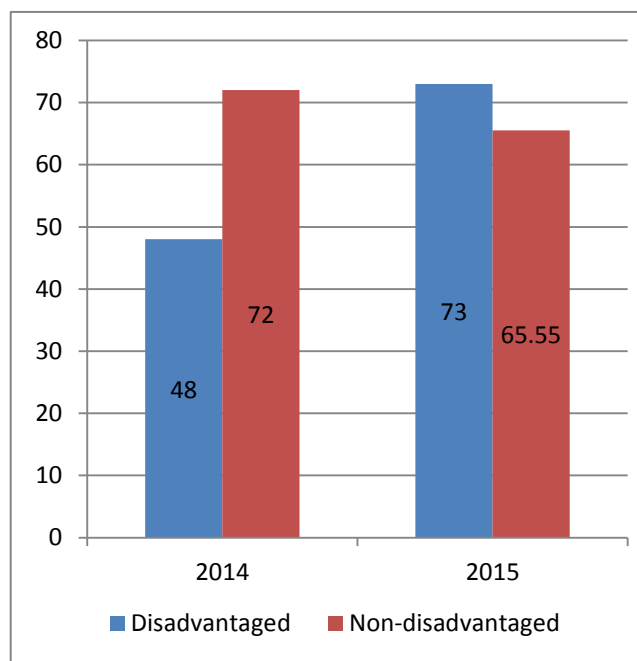
#### 5 A\*- C

The gap has fallen by 12 percentage points between 2014 and 2015 and was -3% in 2015.



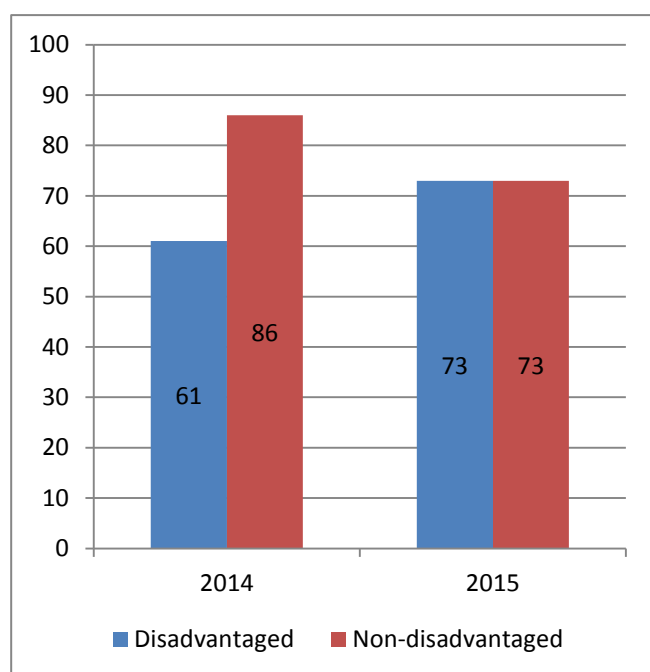
#### 5 A\*-C including English and Maths

Between 2014 and 2015, the gap has fallen by 21.5% from -24% to a positive residual of 7.5%



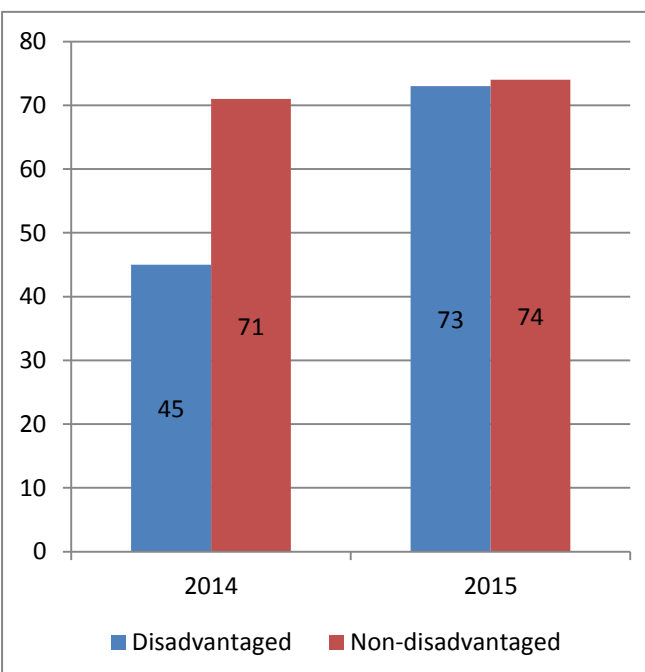
#### Percentage achieving expected progress in English

#### Percentage achieving expected progress in Maths

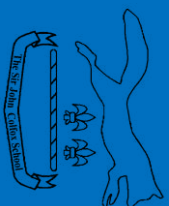
Between 2014 and 2015 the gap has fallen by 25% to -1%



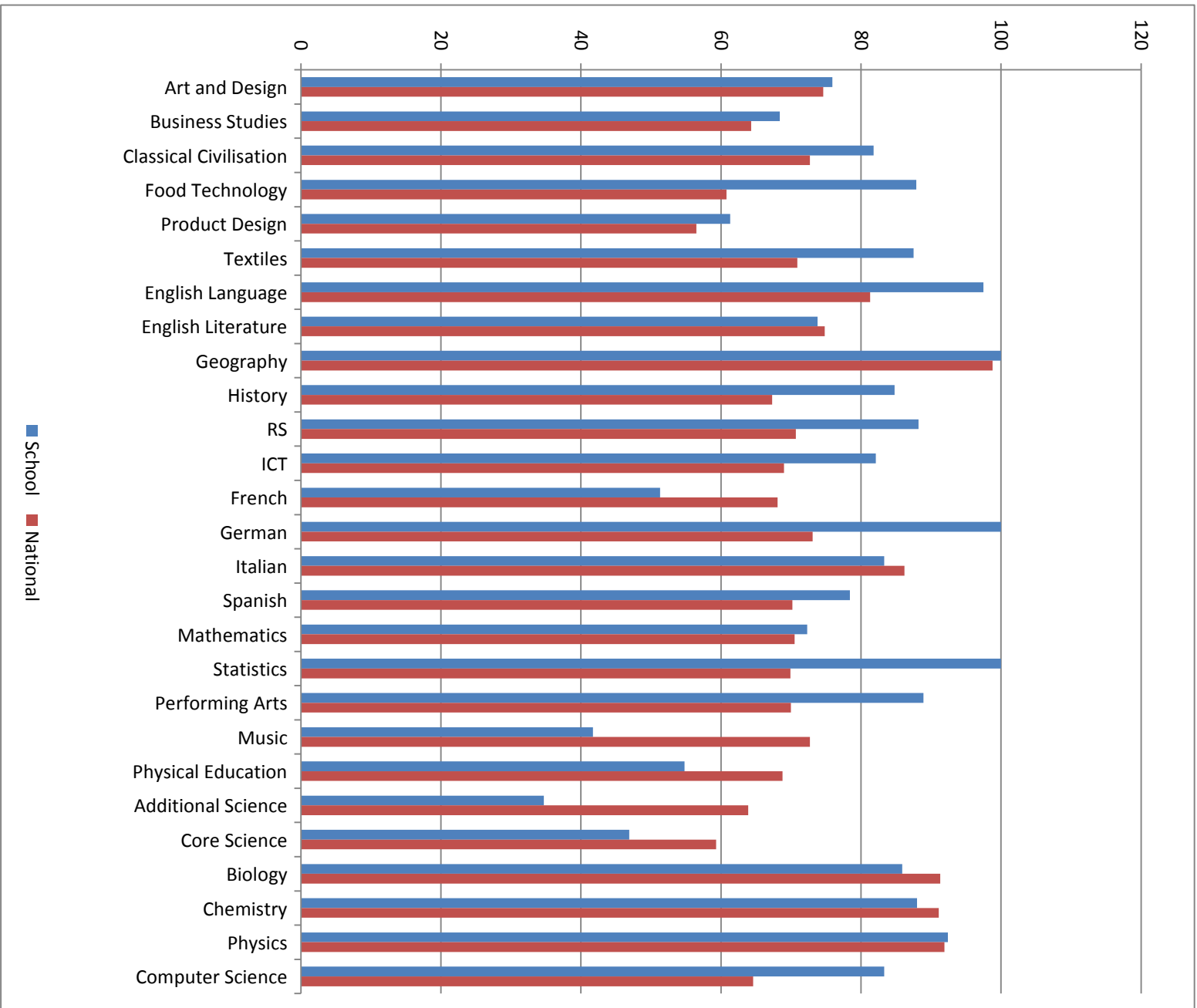

Percentage achieving 37 points (grade C) or above



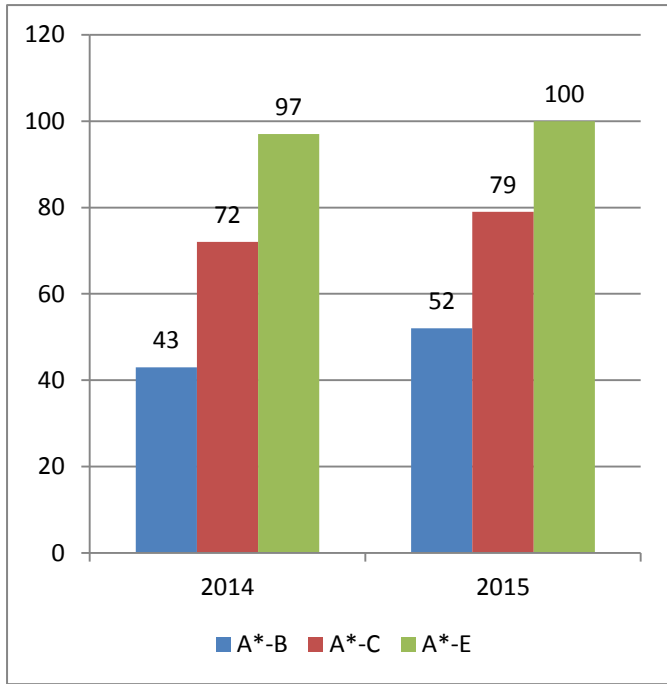
