What is a Defibrillator?

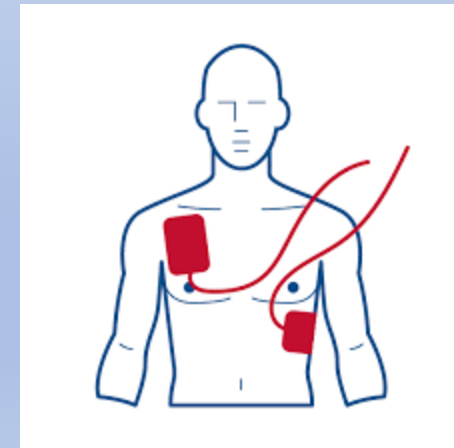
A device that restores a normal heartbeat by sending an electric pulse or shock to the heart.
