AMENDMENT TO BEHAVIOUR FOR LEARNING POLICY

In response to changes we have made to the Academy to as part of our response to Covid-19, we have made some temporary alterations to the Behaviour for Learning Policy. The full Policy and details of the amendments can be found at - <https://www.colfox.org/policies-2015-16/>

The key changes are as follows –

- The following behaviours are now considered more serious and require intervention and sanction:
 - Purposefully coughing or sneezing on someone
 - Spitting
 - Repeated failure to adhere to school routines designed to maintain bubbles and social distancing
 - Deliberate intimidation by standing too close and/or speaking to others inappropriately e.g. shouting or speaking too close to another person
- Changes to the use of the BfL room to ensure that year group bubbles can be maintained.
- Mixed year group Friday after-school detentions will cease and will be replaced by year group specific 30 minute after-school detentions twice weekly to allow for safer distancing.
- Lunchtime detentions will no longer operate.

Thank you to our students for their excellent behaviour in lessons and around the Academy and for helping to ensure that our whole community remains as safe as possible.
