RE: GCSE Results and Appeals

GCSE results day will take place this year on Thursday 12 August 2021. Due to the lifting of Covid restrictions we are really pleased that students will be able to come into school to pick up their results.

Collection of results

Students will be able to collect their results from the Main Hall between 9am – 11am. They should enter via the external doors.

If your results are better or worse than expected, then you will be able to talk to Mr. Teasdale (Head of Sixth Form) in the Hall about your options. We will also be able to direct you to a Careers Advisor for guidance about next steps.

Students who are unable to collect their results in person can request the results to be emailed to the student's school email addresses on results day. You can also give permission for a representative to pick them up on your behalf. These requests need to be made to Terri Davies (Exams Officer) t.davies@colfox.dorset.sch.uk prior to results day. Alternatively, all results not collected will be posted out at the end of results day by first class mail to the student's home address held on our system.

Teacher Assessed Grades/Appeals

You will be aware from previous letters that the GCSE results this year have been calculated using teacher assessed grades (TAGs) instead of students' exams and coursework. Teacher assessed grades were submitted by the school to the exam boards on June 18 2021 and have since gone through a thorough process of standardisation and quality assurance. Autumn Re-sits

Students have the opportunity to sit exams in all subjects in the Autumn Term. I can confirm the dates for the GCSE exams are 1 November – 9 November (Maths and English Language) 15 November – 3 December (All other GCSE subjects).

Further details about the autumn exams, including entry deadlines, will be available after the results day.
