RE: A Level Results and Appeals

A Level results day will take place this year on **Tuesday 10th August**. Due to the lifting of COVID restrictions, we are pleased that students will be able to come into school to pick up their results in person.

Collection of results

Students will be able to collect results from the Main Hall from 9am to 11am.

I will be on hand to discuss next steps. Students will have heard from their chosen universities by email early in the morning whether or not applications have been successful. I will help explain the clearing process – and also the ‘Adjustment’ service – if results are better or worse than expected.

Students who are unable to collect their results in person can request the results to be emailed to the student’s school email address on results day. You can also give permission for a representative to pick them up on your behalf: please contact Terri Davies (Exams Officer: t.davies@colfox.dorset.sch.uk) prior to results day. Alternatively, all results not collected will be posted out at the end of results day by first class mail to the student’s home address held on our system.

Teacher Assessed Grades/Appeals

You will be aware that grades this year have been calculated using teacher assessed grades (TAGs) instead of exams. TAGS were submitted by the school to exam boards on June 18th and have since gone through a thorough process of quality assurance. Please see the attached guide for detailed information about this process.

Autumn Re-sits

Students have the opportunity to sit exams in all subjects in the Autumn Term. A Level exams are planned for October 2021. Further details about the precise date and entry deadlines, will be available after the results day.
