Before you go shopping for new uniform.....

- Take an honest look at what you are wearing to school with your tutor today.
- Now is the time for a reminder of our uniform expectations and the changes agreed after discussion with the Student Council.

Skirts.

- You told us that you found the school skirts from KitzUk expensive and poor quality.
- These skirts remain available to purchase but there is no longer a requirement to do so.
- You can buy a skirt from an alternative retailer but it **MUST** be:
 - Black and be no shorter than **JUST ABOVE THE KNEE**.
 - It **MUST NOT** be 'tube' style.

Skirts. Must not be skinny-fit and sit just above the knee.





Trousers.

- No change to our current uniform code.
- Trousers must be black, not tight-fitting, not denim or chino with no visible stitching.
- They must be full length and worn with **black** socks.

Trousers.

Trousers must be tailored. Trousers that go in at the ankle, jeans, chinos or any form of leggings are not permitted.

Shoes.

- No change to our current uniform code.
- Shoes must be black leather with no visible logo.
- Trainers must not be worn.
- If trainers are needed for medical reasons, a note must be provided and given to the Head of Year.

Shoes.

Shorts.

- Boys and girls can wear black shorts.
- These must be tailored, knee-length and not tight-fitting.
- They must not be denim, chino or contain visible stitching.
- They must be worn with black socks.

Shorts.



Other items of school uniform.

- A list of uniform can be seen on the school website and in student planners.
- If in doubt, it is better to check before purchase!
- A list of common issues can be seen on the next slides.



Uniform.

- Jumpers must be school jumpers with the Colfox logo or plain black, V-necked knitted jumpers and worn under blazers – not instead of them. No other jumper is permitted including hoodies and sweatshirts. Jumpers should not be tucked into skirts or trousers.
- Blazers must be worn at all times during the Autumn and Spring terms. Sleeves must not be rolled up.
- Wearing PE kit outside of PE lessons is no longer permitted.
- Teaching staff will give permission for coats to be worn in class if it is particularly cold. This would be because of ventilation required to help reduce the spread of covid.

Jewellery.

- Students are not permitted to wear more than one of each of the following:
- Ring.
- Bracelet.
- Necklace – small, unobstrusive and worn under clothing.
- Nose piercing – one discreet nose piercing (stud only) - but must be removed for practical lessons.



Mobile phones and other electronic devices.

- Students may have devices for use to and from school.
- When in school (including at break and lunchtimes), these are not permitted, should be switched off and will be confiscated if seen.
- Ear phones should not be used in school.
- THESE RULES ARE IN PLACE FOR SAFEGUARDING PURPOSES.
- The school can not be held responsible for loss of expensive personal equipment. Students must make sure that they are stored securely.
