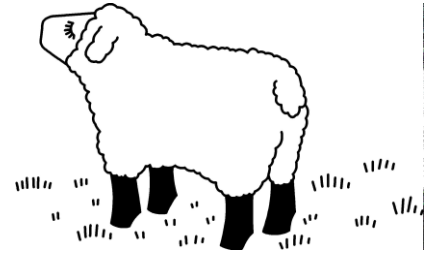


WOOL

- **Wool** is a Natural fibre that comes from animals with fur.



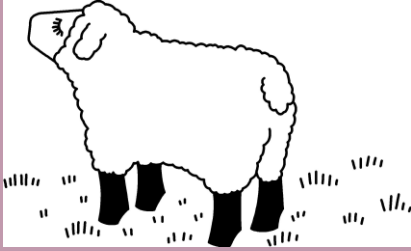
Sheep, goats, llamas and rabbits are all used in the textile industry.

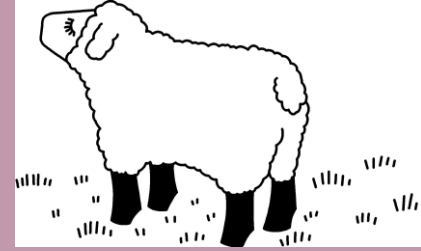

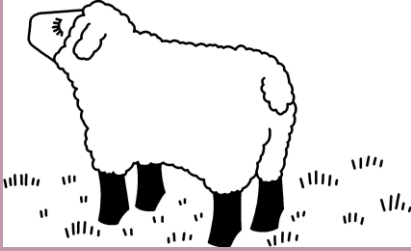
Advantages

- Durable

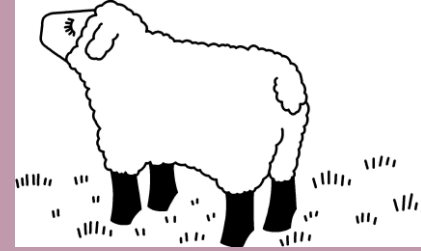


Here are some of the great reasons why wool is such a useful fibre!

- Low moth resistance
- Dries slowly
- Can feel itchy
- Washes poorly, can shrink,
heavy when wet
